Analysis¹⁾

This photograph captures a section of the Memorial to the Murdered Jews of Europe in Berlin. The composition focuses on the repetitive, imposing gray concrete slabs, casting long shadows on the cobblestone pathway between them. The perspective draws the viewer into the labyrinthine space, evoking a sense of disorientation and unease.
