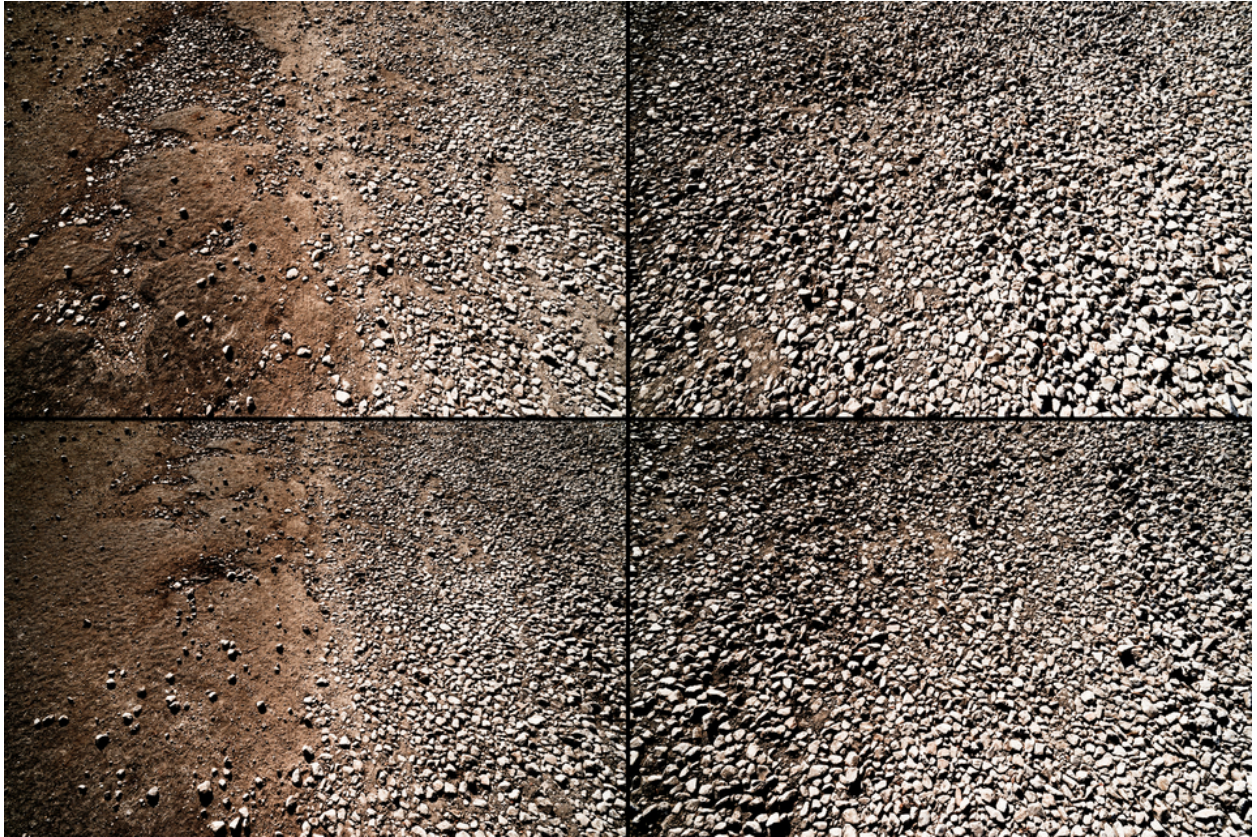

Picture Description¹⁾

Analysis¹⁾

This photograph presents a stark contrast between texture and tone, dividing the composition into four distinct quadrants.
