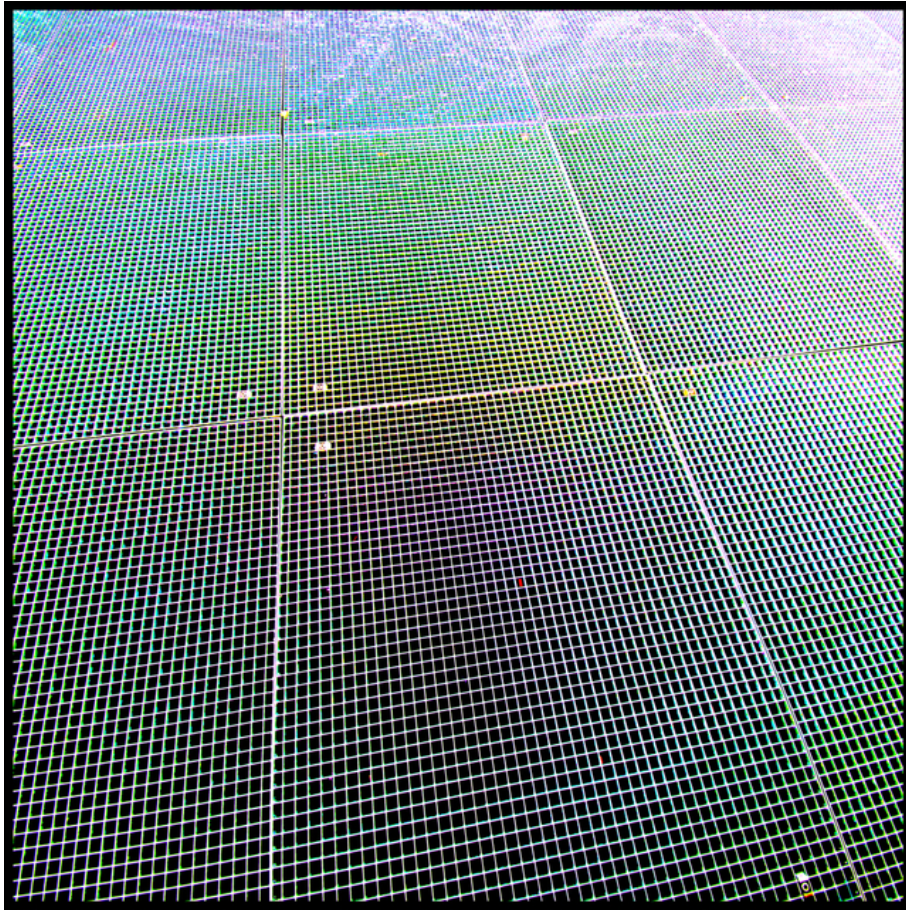

Analysis¹⁾
