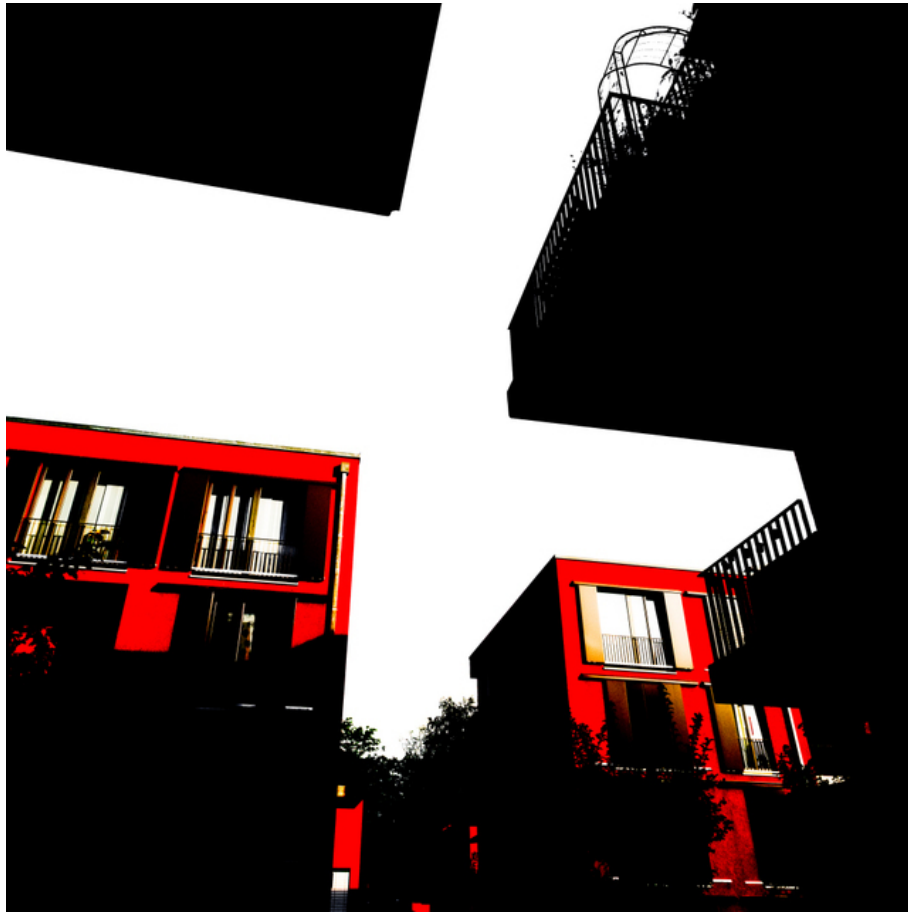

## Picture Description<sup>1)</sup>

## Analysis<sup>1)</sup>
