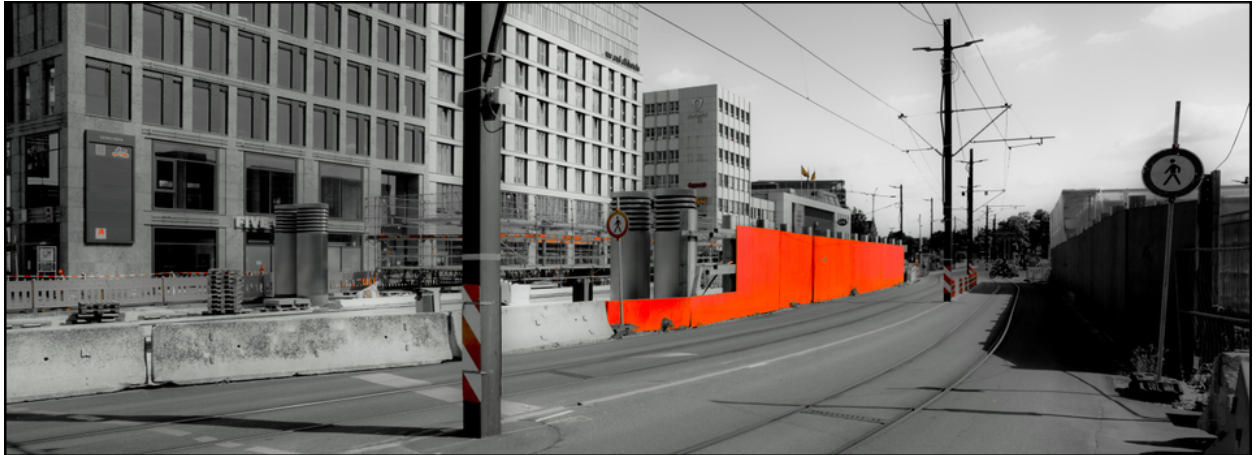

Analysis¹⁾
