Picture Description¹⁾

A monochromatic view across the water towards the Statue of Liberty and a harbor, taken on a foggy day.

Analysis¹⁾

This monochrome photograph captures a hazy, almost ethereal view of the New York harbor. The composition emphasizes the vast expanse of sky and water, which together dominate the photograph with shades of gray.
